 Inpatient Rehabilitation Admission Criteria
 FINAL- July 2009

Can the patient's rehabilitation needs be met at home or in the community? (home, retirement home, supported housing)

- With or without care giver support.
- With or without care giver support + community supports /outpatient.
- With or without care giver support + with or without community supports / outpatient + CCAC.

→ If yes, go home

Is the patient **Medically Stable**?
