

Discharge Linkage Checklist

The following discharge linkage checklist is meant to act as a cue to potential linkages that should be facilitated for a person with stroke and/or their caregiver prior to discharge to the community. Feedback from the person with stroke and their caregiver is essential to incorporate in the completion of this checklist.

Prior to discharge has the healthcare team considered if this person would benefit from linkage to:

- A Primary Care Provider
- Specialized stroke rehabilitation services
- A return to driving program
- A return to work specialist
- A healthcare provider and/or education regarding sexuality
- A healthcare provider and/or education regarding fatigue
- A program focused on engaging in leisure activities
- A community-based resource for engaging in aerobic activities
- Disability support services
- A peer support visitation program
- A peer and caregiver support group in the community
- Stroke Prevention Services
- Health and Wellness programs
- Appropriate transportation services
- Financial support services
- Housing support services
- Community care services

If any of the above categories have been indicated as a potential need for this person, please consider making an appropriate referral prior to discharge.
