

CPVID-19 System Planning Updates

- CorHealth is hosting a combined COVID-19 Stakeholder Forums (cardiac, stroke, and vascular stakeholders) weekly, as necessary
 - Two Forums have occurred to date (April 21st & 28th)
 - Highlights include: ICU Capacity, EMS transfer considerations, and HHR pressures
 - Forum Summaries and Presentations are available <u>here</u>
- The MOH re-released Directive #2 on April 20, 2021 to ramp down non-urgent and non-emergent procedures and surgeries
 - CorHealth clinical Guidance Memos continue to provide relevant guidance to providers as we navigate through COVID-19 Wave 3
